Troy Traffic Jam: 8th Annual Classic Car Show Winners

(TROY, MI) – Car enthusiasts came out on Sunday, August 2 for the 8th annual Troy Traffic Jam, an exciting classic car show in the City of Troy. Troy Traffic Jam at the Columbia Center on August 2 combined all of the fun and excitement of traditional car shows with entertaining music from DJ Bob Steel and delicious food from Troy restaurants Insalata, Gateway Deli and Troy's Zoyo Neighborhood Yogurt, plus free coffee and timbits from Tim Hortons Troy and a huge collection of specialty vehicles.

More than 250 cars were on site and judged for best in class awards as well as for best of show. Again this year, Troy Traffic Jam included some of the most jaw dropping sports and race cars from Ken Lingenfelter, Penske and the Suburban Collection including; a Cadillac pre-production CTSV with a Corvette engine; Copo Camaro; 2014 La Ferrari; 2008 Karl's Custom Corvette resembling a 1967; a 2014 Chevrolet wide body C7 Corvette and a 2015 Chevrolet Z06 Corvette.

There was also a 1957 Cadillac Eldorado from the GM Heritage Collection; a 1932 Stutz DV-32 Super Bearcat from Terry Adderley, CEO at Kelly Services; and a 2015 Chrysler Challenger Hellcat and 1970 Pontiac GTO from Kirco's own Alan Kiriluk.
